| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>Juvenile court is only 10-15% of court referrals, no data w/ Circuit Municipal courts</i>                                                                                                   |
| <b>3) Diversion:</b>             | Includes alternative handling, formal diversion w/ or without supervision, referral to other program, services                                                                                 |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>No state-wide data collection / some data possible at local levels</i>                                                                                                                      |
| <b>4) Detention:</b>             | Juvenile detention center placement / 48 hour holding-staff secure / adult jail lock-up                                                                                                        |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>No problem with data from 2007 forward; and earlier data maybe OK</i>                                                                                                                       |
| <b>5) Petition filed:</b>        | Includes Juvenile Court Petition, Municipal Court charge, Circuit Court charge                                                                                                                 |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>Juvenile Court only is 10-15% of juvenile arrests; Circuit Court does not report juvenile data; Municipal Courts have no data reporting requirements, much less juvenile data</i>           |
| <b>6) Found Delinquent:</b>      | Adjudicated in Juvenile Court, guilty in Municipal and Circuit Court                                                                                                                           |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>Juvenile Court only is 10-15% of juvenile arrests; Circuit Court does not report juvenile data; Municipal Courts have no data reporting requirements, much less juvenile data</i>           |
| <b>7) Probation Supervision:</b> | Supervision by county or state juvenile probation agency                                                                                                                                       |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>DFS only statewide reporting; Sweetwater and Campbell County under contract w/ DFS contrary to state statute, but do they use state WyCaps system? No other reporting required locally.</i> |
| <b>8) Secure Confinement:</b>    | Juvenile Detention as a sentence (not holding for hearings or pending disp. or placement) Wyoming Boys' School, <del>Wyoming Girls' School</del>                                               |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>No problem except determining sentenced youth in juvenile detention. This data should be available through the DFS system and juvenile detention roster</i>                                 |
| <b>9) Transfer:</b>              | Direct file as Adult Felony Charge                                                                                                                                                             |
| <b>Current Problem</b>           | <i>Not reported centrally, could possibly be accessed by each Adult felony jurisdiction, either through District Court or Co. /District Atty</i>                                               |

# ***SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT (SPC) IMPLEMENTATION SUGGESTIONS FOR UNIFORM DATA COLLECTION PROCESS***

Single point of contact authority is given to the County Attorney / District Attorney. For reporting purposed it could be the Co./District Attorney designee, e.g. staff in office or another agency etc.

## **Data Entry Responsibility of Single Point of Contact Contact points 1-5, 9**

### **1) Arrest / Citation**

Law enforcement reports to DCI for Uniform Crime Report and Includes racial information

SPC: logs: *Juvenile Profile*; name/race/ DOB/ crime/ gender/ arresting/ jurisdiction/ address/

PACT pre-screen – check information on domains
